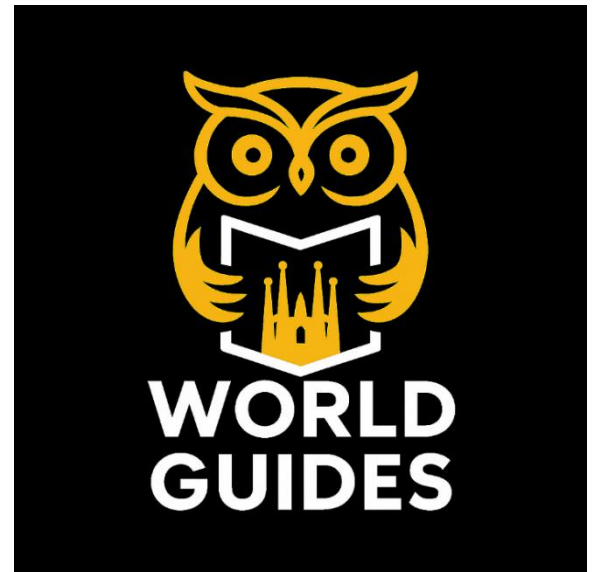
General Information

- The standard price is € 830.

Day 1

Day 2

- Want to join the included guided tour? Programme starts at 10:30. The tour will focus on the rich history Barcelona. From it's humble Roman beginning to the times of the city as a major hub in the Spanish empire. You will see the highlights of the city, be able to ask questions and of course we will visit the best places for making photos.
- The guided tour ends a bit before 13:00. Then, Thomas will provide you with tickets to Gaudí's unfinished [Sagrada Familia](#) (we can, unfortunately, not give tours here). Thomas will provide directions.
- In the evening there is no programme, but don't forget to ask Thomas for tips and ideas. He knows his way around Barcelona.

Day 3

- Today, we start with a morning walk in [Parc Guëll](#). Tickets are arranged for this in the morning slot so it is not very crowded. Gaze at the amazing creativity that makes the city and it's greatest artists come alive in front of you.
- After this, it is time to go to our next destination: Valencia. We will take the bus or train (luggage can be stored in the morning).
- For those that still have energy and want to take a walk and a drink, a pub-crawl will be organised in the evening. In the historical center.

Day 4

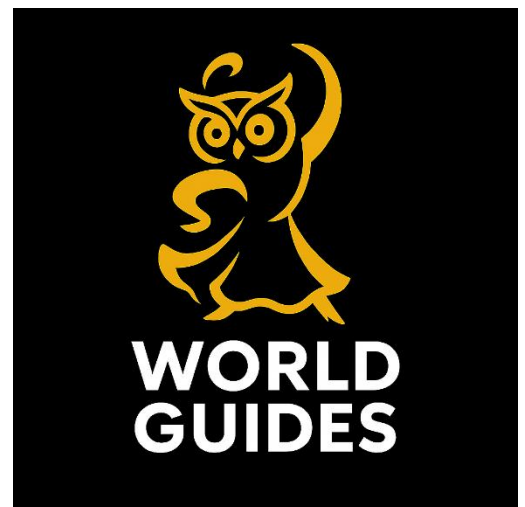

What is included?

Accommodations

- To keep costs low, accommodation is arranged at all locations in checked and comfortable hostels or bungalow parks.
- Beds are arranged in dorm rooms. This is standard.
- If guests want single room accommodation (or multiple-bed private rooms if they are travelling together), please select this during the initial form.
This will have an effect on the final price but we would be more than happy to find you accommodation that meet your needs.
- Breakfast is included in Barcelona and Valencia.

Travel

- Travel will happen by train or buses between destination.
- Included in the price are multiple-day travel tickets to use on local transportation.

Guided Tours

- Guided tours, terrace meetings and pub crawls that are mentioned in the programme are included in the price (not the drinks). If you were blown away by the tours, an extra tip is always welcome.

On-site assistance

- Thomas will be your tour guide and travel assistant. You can always contact him during the trip, also through WhatsApp, for any questions or problems that may occur for the duration of the trip.

Attractions

- Tickets for Parc Guëll, the Sagrada Familia and the Torres de Serrano are included.
- A ticket to either the Palau de les Arts Reina Sofiá OR the Valencia Aquarium are included.
- A ticket to either the Royal Palace in Madrid OR the Prado Museum OR the Museo de América are included.

What is not included?

- World Guides does not provide *travel or health insurance*. We strongly recommend that all participants arrange their own insurance before departure to ensure they are fully covered for medical care, cancellations, luggage, and unexpected situations.
- Meals and drinks are not included unless noted in our offer.
- Flights or transportation to the starting point and from the ending point are not included.
- Personal expenses.
- The accommodations might ask for a small amount of money for a cash deposit. This will be refunded upon check-out if no damages occur.
- VISA costs, required for non-EU travellers is not included.
- Seat reservations on the trains are not required nor included.
- Private rooms or upgrades are not included unless paid for separately in advance.
- Costs due to strikes, weather, or missed connections unless caused by the agency are not covered.
