Welcome aboard — let's make memories.



General Information

- The price is € 620.
- The programme starts on 16-07-2026 in **Frankfurt** and finishes on 26-07-2026 in **Berlin**.
- Given the nature of this tour we accept everyone aged 18 and older.
- Your tour guide is **Thomas Visser**. He is 35 years old, an ally and loves travel, cats, Mexican food and classical music.
- A basic level of fitness is recommended, as the tour includes walking, stairs, and public transport. Are you a person with reduced mobility? Contact us to see what is possible.
- We travel with a maximum of 30 people.
- All communication, tours, and guidance during the programme will be in **English**. Languages spoken by our tour leader are English, German, Dutch and basic Spanish.
- Accommodation will be in shared hostel rooms (mixed or same gender), unless you request an upgrade to a private room where available.
- This tour is LGBTQIA+ inclusive, open-minded, and respectful. We expect all participants to treat each other with kindness and respect.
- Your booking is confirmed only after receiving the full payment or the required deposit.
- The programme is subject to minor changes due to weather, local events, or operational reasons.

Saturday 18-07-2026 Pride Frankfurt!


 Today is the parade! Join the many celebrations, parties and festivities across town.

Then our tour takes us across the river, through a historic neighbourhood called Malá Strana. Then, we cross the famous Charles Bridge, and enter the historical centre. There, the tour will end around 14:00.
- There is an organised pub crawl in the evening, showing some of the nice bars and places to be in Prague.

 - A visit to the Prague National Museum




Wednesday 22-07-2026 Cooling down

The guided tour will finish around 13:00.

What is included?

Accommodations

- To keep costs low, accommodation is arranged at all locations in checked and comfortable hostels.
- Beds are arranged in dorm rooms. This is standard.
- If guests want single room accommodation (or multiple-bed private rooms if they are travelling together), please communicate this with us during booking. This will have an effect on the final price (not always) but we would be more than happy to find you accommodation that meet your needs.
- Breakfast is included in the standard Hostels in Frankfurt and Prague, but not Berlin.

International travel

- Travel will take place with trains or buses between destinations.
- Included in the price are multiple-day travel tickets to use on: Metro in Berlin (physical) Metro, tram and bus in Prague (digital).

Guided Tours

• Guided tours and pub crawls that are mentioned in the programme are included in the price (not the drinks in the pub-crawl). If you were blown away by the tours, an extra tip is always welcome.

On-site assistance

• Thomas will be your tour guide and travel assistant. You can always contact him during the trip, also through WhatsApp, for any questions or problems that may occur for the duration of the trip.

Attractions

- Tickets and/or visits to the Museum of Topography of Terrors in Berlin, the Reichstag excursion, The Prague Castle complex are included.
- Tickets to either a Cruise in Prague OR a visit to the Prague Beer Museum OR a a visit to the Prague National Museum are included.

What is not included?

- World Guides does **not** provide **travel or health insurance**. We strongly recommend that all participants arrange their own insurance before departure to ensure they are fully covered for medical care, cancellations, baggage, and other unexpected situations.
- Meals and drinks except during breakfast in Frankfurt and Prague are not included.
- Flights or transportation to and/or from the start or ending locations are not included.
- Personal expenses.
- The accommodations might ask for a small amount of money for a cash deposit.
 This will be refunded upon check-out if no damages occur.
- VISA costs, required for non-EU travellers is not included.
- Seat reservations on the International train are not required but optional and not included. Check the Interail/Eurail website if seat reservations are required for your journey back.
- Private rooms or upgrades are not included unless paid for separately in advance.
- Costs due to strikes, weather, or missed connections unless caused by the agency are not covered.
